### FCFI Prayer Guide - June 2022

1. *Again, the word of the Lord Almighty came to me. This is what the Lord Almighty says, I am very jealous for Zion. I am burning with jealousy for her, (Zechariah 8:1). Israel was God's chosen people. His promise of forgiveness and restoration extends to all of God's Believers wherever they may be found. This should be such a comfort to all of us. We pray to remember we are God's chosen and He is jealous for us to be in a relationship with Him. **Please continue to pray for Uvalde, Texas and the aftermath of the terrible shooting.***
2. *Oh, that one of you would shut the Temple doors so that you would not light useless fires on my altar! I am not pleased with you, says the Lord almighty and I will accept no offering from your hands, (Malachi 1:10). The priests were casually accepting sacrificial animals that were blemished. We often accept casual sin. God is not pleased with either. We pray to stand firm in this day and time of sinfulness. **4-5 Vermont Dairy Festival, Enosburg Falls, VT, Bill Brown.***
3. *Settle matters quickly with your adversary who is taking you to court. Do it while you are still with him on the way, or he may hand you over to the judge, and the judge may hand you over to the officer, and you may be thrown into prison. I tell you the truth, you will not get out until you have paid the last penny, (Matthew 5:23-24). Our attitudes toward others reflect our relationship with God. 4. *And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years. She had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, yet instead of getting better she grew worse. When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind Him in the crowd and touched His cloak, because she thought, If I just touch His clothes, I will be healed. Immediately her bleeding stopped, and she felt in her body that she was freed from her suffering,* (Mark 5:25-29). This woman's bold approach to touch Jesus brought her physical healing and brought her back into society. Her testimony was one told until this day. 6. *You (Nicodemus) should not be surprised at My saying. You must be born again. The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So, it is with everyone born of the Spirit.* (John 3:7-8). We are born of the flesh when we are physically born. Then, we are born of the Spirit when we confess Jesus as our Lord and Savior. 7. *But, since they (the Sanhedrin) could see the man who had been healed standing there with them, there was nothing they could say, so they ordered them (Peter and John) to withdraw from the Sanhedrin and then conferred together. 29. *Aaron's sons Nadab and Abihu took their censers, put fire in them and added incense, and they offered unauthorized fire before the Lord, contrary to His command. So, fire came out from the presence of the Lord and consumed them and they died before the Lord,* (Leviticus 10:1-2). The right thing done the wrong way can have devastating consequences. These men knew they were in the wrong but did it anyway. We pray to remember obedience is always better than sacrifice, (Deuteronomy 1:11-13). A wise leader knows when to ask for help. Moses was not relinquishing his leadership he was leading better with the help of others. We pray to understand leadership is a ministry and not a dictatorship. **Please pray for Dick Kenyon, he had pneumonia and is still recovering.**
  
30. *Achan replied, It is true. I have sinned against the Lord, the God of Israel. This is what I have done: when I saw in the plunder a beautiful robe from Babylonia, two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold weighting fifty shekels, I coveted them and took them. They are hidden in the ground inside my tent with the silver underneath,* (Joshua 7:20-21). Our sin isn't against each other, even though we can do harm to others. We sin against God. We pray to remember lust leads to sin and to keep our thoughts pure. **Please continue to pray for Tyler and Serena, they lost a little baby boy two weeks before delivery...life is sometimes very hard.**

24. *And now, dear children, continue in Him, so that when He appears, we may be confident and unashamed before Him at His coming,* (1John 2:28). Good deeds do not produce Salvation, but they are a necessary proof that true faith is present in the life of a Believer. We pray to be a people of good deeds. **Please pray for a family who's one son accidentally shot and killed his 22-year-old brother.**
25. *These are the men who divide you, who follow mere natural instincts and do not have the Spirit,* (Jude 19). Scoffers will try and intimidate Believers...we must know the truth and stand in the truth especially in these times we are living in. We pray to be diligent in asking the Spirit to give us wisdom. **Farmer's Market, Syracuse, NY, Bill Brown**
26. *They called to the mountains and the rocks, Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! For the great day of their wrath has come, and who can stand,* (Revelations 6:16-17). To Believers God is a gentle Savior who offers reward rather than punishment. Those who have rejected God cannot survive the day of His wrath. We pray as Believers to share God's love, grace, and forgiveness to all we can, as long as we can. **Please continue to pray for Bill and Kathy Brown and their health concerns.**

19. *They must be silenced, because they are ruining whole households by teaching things they ought not to teach, and that for the sake of dishonest gain, (Titus 1:11).* Deceivers have always been around ... they often take bits and pieces of truth and twist and turn until they make a lie out of truth. We pray to fill our minds with truth from God's Word and not fall for evil devices of men. **Please pray for Milton, he has just found out he has stage 4 cancer.**
20. *Both the One who makes men holy and those who are made holy are of the same family. So, Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers, (Hebrews 2:11).* God has adopted all Believers as His children thus Jesus calls them His brothers and sisters. We pray to know we have been cleansed and made holy through Jesus and are set apart for God's service. **Please pray for those who need services for their family members and can't get them through the system.**
21. *But the man that looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing it, he will be blessed in what he does, (James 1:25).* As Believers we are free to live as God created us to live, not do as we please.
